### August 30th 2020 22nd Sunday of Ordinary Time - Year A - Matthew 16:21 - 27

This weeks gospel speaks of an incident which happens at a very significant moment in the life of Jesus. Up until now he met with great success in Galilee. Large crowds followed him and his fame spread throughout Syria. Then opposition to him grew, mainly from Scribes and Pharisees. He decided that the time had come to confront these opposing forces at the seat of their power, Jerusalem their home. This decision had tragic consequences which he accepted.
