Read and re-read, out loud and slowly the Gospel
Meditate on reading as being spoken to you, an experience in your life
January 15<sup>th</sup> 2012 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday Ordinary Time – Year B – John 1:35-42

In this week's gospel we have the account of the calling of the first disciples. We also have the testimony of St. John the Baptist "Look there is the Lamb of God". The meeting of Jesus and the disciples is simple and down to earth. Jesus asked them "What do you want" and they replied "Where do you live" to which he replied "Come and See" and they did.
