November 4th 2012 31st Sunday Ordinary Time – Year B – Mark 12:28-34

In this week's gospel we see Jesus in dialogue with the scribe about which in his view is the first commandment. Jesus answers him by telling him about two commandments – Love God and love your neighbour as yourself. He was saying there is no real love of God without love of neighbour and no lasting love of neighbour without love of God.

How do we put this commandment into practice? Who is my neighbour? Do we really feel Jesus believes in us and loves us? This is the message he wants us to bring to and share with our neighbour.
