In this week's gospel Jesus tells his disciples to be aware of the scribes who walk about in long robes and take the places of honour at banquets and do not notice the actions of the poor widow giving all she had. These scribes were acting out of self interest while she was acting out of her love for Jesus and He noticed this.
