The joint Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) for St Pius X and St Judes met this week. It was noted that there was good attendance by our volunteers at the Child Safeguarding Information sessions, however we need to encourage all volunteers to attend as soon as possible. The Sacrament of Confirmation was celebrated in St Pius X last weekend, it was a beautiful and joyful celebration, thanks to all involved, in particular to our parish staff, volunteers and the school communities. The Sacrament of First Penance has also taken place in both parishes. Preparations are underway for the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation in St Judes and for the celebration of First Holy Communion in both parishes which will take place during May.

As we approach Holy Week and the Easter Liturgies, again with the support of our parish staff and volunteers, we look forward to celebrating these liturgies with our parish communities. Easter Cards including details of all Easter services are currently being distributed to the homes in both parishes.

Building Hope and pastoral initiatives remain a priority, with the upcoming pilgrimage to Knock, and there were discussions on ways to develop initiatives such as the Young Adult Faith Group and further outreach in our schools.
