Gospel Reflections for Lent 4th Sunday in Lent 15: 1-3, 11-32 6th, March, 2016

In this Sunday's gospel we have the story of the Prodigal son. This is a very well known story to us all. Jesus told this story in response to the self righteous scribes and Pharisees who were commenting on Him 'welcoming sinners and eating with them'. Jesus welcomed all, even the 'tax collectors and sinners' who often came to listen to him. The very warm welcome and forgiveness of the father in today's gospel is very similar to the welcome Jesus had for all. Through his mercy and forgiveness Jesus brings new life to his people. The younger son in today's gospel story also received new life through the welcome and forgiveness of his father " your brother here was dead and has come to life; he was lost and is found" was the fathers response to his older son when he felt hard done by as he had spent all his time at home. When has the experience of human love and forgiveness helped you to think of and be thankful for the love and compassion of God for you? Let us all during this season of lent turn to God who is waiting to receive us with joy.
